The clinical assessment of suicidal behavior of children or adolescents must consider the developmental level of the cognitive capacity of a specific child or adolescent. In general, the assessment of suicidal behavior requires a sufficient amount of time to evaluate multiple factors that are associated with suicidal behavior.

Although they may have a strong preventive role, some of the recommendations made are often impossible in settings with limited resources, such as "any youth suspected of possibly being suicidal should be supervised at all times and should never be left alone under any circumstances" (page 40) and "individualized suicide risk assessments should be conducted if there is any reason to even suspect a student might be suicidal or potentially suicidal" (page 85).
