A hematoma can result from an injury to any type of blood vessel (artery, vein, or small capillary). A hematoma usually describes bleeding which has more or less clotted, whereas a hemorrhage signifies active, ongoing bleeding. Hematoma is a very common problem encountered by many people at some time in their lives.

Hematoma: Types, Symptoms, Pictures, Causes & Treatments

Auricular hematomas are caused by direct blunt trauma to the anterior auricle, occurring most commonly in wrestlers, boxers, and rugby players. Trauma can cause a hematoma that separates the auricular perichondrium from the underlying cartilage and interrupts blood vessels that nourish the cartilage. If the perichondrium and its vessels are not reattached to the cartilage, there can be scarring and permanent deformity of the cartilage (cauliflower ear).
