The first coat should be a light, misting coat to the instrument – often referred to as a "tack-coat." After 45-minutes or so, apply another, more deliberate "wet-coat." Future coats should be wet, and be sure to give 1-2 hours between coats to allow the solvents to rise out of the finish.
