In-Text Citation When you include information from a lab manual in text, put a citation inside parentheses. Insert the name of the issuer of the manual, such as a company, a college department or an instructor's surname. Add a comma and then list the publication year, such as: (Department of Physics, 2012).

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

Type or write the first question in your list followed by a question mark, leaving one space between the period after the question number and the first word of the question. Capitalize the first word of the question and any proper nouns like names. For example, you type or write "1.

The Citation-Order System (typically used in engineering--IEEE documentation). Citations : When you cite the sources of information in the report, you give a number in brackets that corresponds to the number of the source listed in the order in which they appear in the report, the source listed first as [1], the next source [2], etc.

Citations and References: Documenting your Sources

Start your full citation with the name of the instructor. List the instructor's last name first, followed by a comma. Then write out their first name. Place a period after the end of the instructor's name.

Start your Works Cited entry with the author's name, if provided. If an individual author is listed for the web page you want to cite, type their last name first, followed by a comma, then their first name. Place a period at the end of the name.

4 Ways to Cite a Website - wikiHow

If you cite from different volumes of a multivolume work, always include the volume number followed by a colon. Put a space after the colon, then provide the page number(s). (If you only cite from one volume, provide only the page number in parentheses.)

MLA In-Text Citations: The Basics // Purdue Writing Lab

If the lab manual was created by a staff member or department of the school and is only available through class, cite it as an unpublished work. The rules for in-text citations will be the same. If a department prepared the manual, use it for the name in the citation. For the works cited page of an unpublished manual, you can follow this format.

If a DOI is available, cite the DOI number instead of the URL. Online newspapers and magazines sometimes include a "permalink," which is a shortened, stable version of a URL. Look for a "share" or "cite this" button to see if a source includes a permalink. If you can find a permalink, use that instead of a URL.
