The Samsung Galaxy S8 has a 5.8-inch display, a resolution of 1440 x 2960 pixels and a pixel density of 570 PPI. The Sony Xperia XA1 Ultra has a 6.0-inch screen, a resolution of 1080 x 1920 pixels and a pixel density of 367 PPI.

How PPI will be calculated? Resolution: WidthxHeight = 1920x1080 Diagonal = $\sqrt{(1920)^2 + (1080)^2} = 2202.91$ PPI = Diagonal÷Screen Size 2202.91 ÷ 5.5 = 400.5 PPI for 5.5-inch screen is 400

Lets assume an artist created a new image at this monitor resolution of 1920 pixels, possibly intended for the web without regard to printing. Rewriting the formula above can tell us the pixel density (PPI) of the image on the monitor display: PPI (monitor) = Number of Pixels / Size in Inches = 1920 / 24 = 80 p p i.

PPI resolution is What PPI means. PPI, or pixels per inch, refers both to the fixed number of pixels that a screen can display and the density of pixels within a digital image. Pixel count on the other hand refers to the number of pixels across the length and width of a digital image—that is, the image dimensions in pixels.

This threshold depends on the distance at which we typically look at the screen, as well as the size of the screen. For example, the iPhone XR PPI is 326 while the iMac with a 5K display has 218 ppi. The iPhone XR PPI count is clearly higher since we tend to look at our smartphones much closer than we (should) look at a computer monitor.

In the case of a monitor with an industry standard Full HD 1080p resolution, this display has a resolution of 1920 x 1080. This means that the screen will have a width of 1,920 pixels while the height of the screen will be 1,080 pixels. This results in a grand total of 2,073,600 pixels on-screen.

In the context of screens, DPI (Dots Per Inch) or PPI (Pixels Per Inch) refer to the number of device pixels per inch, also called "pixel density". The higher the number, the smaller the size of the pixels, so graphics are perceived as more crisp and less pixelated. The concept of DPI is also used in printing, although the dots and their formation is different there.

It has a vertical resolution of 2880 pixels and a horizontal resolution of 1800 pixels, giving it a high display resolution, with 5,184,000 (5 Million+) pixels packed into a 15 inch area. That's more pixels than a full HD TV, which only has 1920 x 1080 resolution, and relatively a lower PPI.

Pixel Density vs Resolution: What's The Difference?

The screen resolution is the number of physical pixels present on a screen where viewport size is the number of CSS pixels on a screen. One CSS pixel can equal one or a different number of physical pixels. And the ratio between the physical pixels and the CSS pixels is DPR or CSS Pixel Ratio. PPI, on the other hand, is the number of physical pixels present in an inch of a screen.

Difference Between Viewport, Screen Resolution, DPR, and ...

The resolution for any particular screen is a fixed quantity. Screen resolutions vary between devices and are continually getting better. The pixel count of my 15" MacBook Pro Retina screen is 2,880 x 1,800 pixels, and its resolution is 221 PPI. An iPhone X has a pixel count of 1,125 x 2,436 and a resolution of 463 PPI.
