Below are the top 5 symptoms. 1) Acceleration Delays – If you step on the gas pedal and there is a slight delay before the acceleration kicks in, then you could have a slipping transmission problem.

5 Transmission Slipping Symptoms (and Common Causes)

Foul Smell or Burning Odor. When the clutch temperature gets too hot, either caused by the driver "riding the clutch" or driving aggressively, the facings may become overheated and begin to burn, giving off a peculiar odor. If the clutch has no chance to cool, it may be ruined as may the flywheel and/or pressure plate.

Signs You May Have a Transmission Leak Your transmission can leak transmission fluid for a number of reasons. There may be a hole in the pan, caused by punctures from road debris, scraping the bottom of your car on a speed bump, or wear and tear. The seals around the gaskets may be worn due to age, or the plugs may not be fully tightened.

Signs, Causes, and Prevention of an Overheating Transmission

Your car may function poorly: it may start out slowly even though the engine is racing. Or it may be hard to get the car into reverse, or into gear at all. Noises may indicate a problem: your clutch pedal may make noise, or your transmission may make noise when the car is in neutral.
