Use mentor text picture books to teach problem and solution text structure which improves reading and writing skills including making informed predictions. Show children what to expect in a problem-solution story as well as how authors structure a problem-solution story or essay. While there are many picture books that model problem and solution, these are my favorites.

### Picture Books to Teach Problem and Solution | Imagination Soup

Give students an example of a problem that happened in class. Situations on problem and solution present themselves daily in an elementary classroom. If you have none recent to use, tell about one from your life. Explain and define the problem. Once you get to the place in the story where the problem has been resolved, explain that this is a solution. It is important to introduce and use the proper vocabulary terms even for younger students.

Using Animated Shorts to Teach Problems and Solutions. If you are looking to add some high interest activities to your lessons, try using animated shorts to teach problems and solutions. This post contains the animated short “ Taking the Plunge ” found on Vimeo and inserted in this post.

### Using Animated Shorts to Teach Problems and Solutions ...

Tell students that together you are going to learn how to identify the problem and solution in a story. Review the definition of problem (the conflict that gets in the way of the main character getting what they want or need) and solution (a resolution or answer that helps the main character solve the problem; the solution is not always the conclusion of the story).

You might start with solutions that have already been tried, and then move to creative solutions. Step One: Divide into groups of 3-4. Assign each group a problem discussed previously or have them pick one of the problems listed.

Answer: A problem solution essay is a type of argument essay. In fact, solving a problem is the last step in thinking about any issue and is often the most important and complicated step. The advantage of choosing this sort of essay is that you get a chance to explain in detail how you think a problem can be solved.

How to Write a Problem Solution Essay: Step-by-Step ...

Experts (teachers) in a particular field are often so fluent in solving problems from that field that they can find it difficult to articulate the problem solving principles and strategies they use to novices (students) in their field because these principles and strategies are second nature to the expert.

Tell students that the purpose of a problem-solution text is for the author to inform the reader about a problem and present solutions to

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the problem. While referring to the template for the text structure map, explain that each section contains a feature of the text structure that helps the author achieve that purpose.

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
