Paul Torrance, nicknamed "the father of creativity", began researching creativity in order to improve American education.

The Incomplete Figure Test is part of the larger Torrance Test of Creative Thinking, which was developed by Ellis Paul Torrance in 1966. The test was updated in 1974, 1984, 1990, 1998 and 2008. Today, it is the most used creativity test in the world and predicts creative achievement better than any other creativity test.

Developing Creative Talent in Art is a guide for parents, teachers and others interested in developing creative art talent of young people. Visual art has its own language system by which the artist communicates to others thoughts, ideas and feelings about the world as they see them. First experienced as images and then codified in art language form, information about the world in this dual form is processed by creative imagination to produce original art works. Both the language of visual art and creative processing techniques are presented by example and instructional application so that students can compose art not only intuitively but also at will.
